Hurricane and Volcano Pose Dangerous Threat to Island



The island of Montserrat, population 12,800, located in the Caribbean, south of Puerto Rico is in great danger. There is threat of Volcanoes and Hurricanes, which could be fatal for all inhabitants. Harris, Tuitts, Farnells Yard and Fergus Mount have all been evacuated. If you live in one of these towns make sure you are ready, and if your town hasn't been mentioned then keep watching TV incase there is an update

Residents of Tar River are being evacuated to the capital Plymouth, pictured right, and residents of Trants are being evacuated to Lake Hill. The emergency response team keeps bringing in news updates, and the hurricane is heading for the East coast, while the volcano has seen an increase in tremors and rock fall. They say that the volcano is likely to affect Tar River Valley, which is currently being evacuated.



Reports suggest that the South of the island is under threat from the volcano, whereas the North is under threat from the ash clouds and the hurricane. Long Ground has now been evacuated
